HIGHER THINGS INFORMATION AND FINANCIAL UPDATE:

At Higher Things Montana, our high schoolers will gather with approximately 1,000 LCMS youth from around the country & spend 4 days immersed in the Gospel through worship services, breakout

sessions, & plenary speakers. Youth will choose which breakout sessions to attend based on the topics that interest them the most! Traveling with our charter sleeper bus, we'll make stops in the Black Hills, SD & at Yellowstone. Our biggest expense is transportation. The cost is about \$1,540 per person. We will be receiving a grant that will cover about 40% of the cost as well as the fundraising we have been doing all year (chili cookoff, Super Bowl sub sale, Easter breakfast, envelope giving wall), we have raised about 60% of the cost so far.

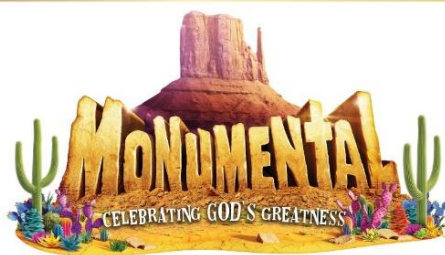
